



Call 9-1-1 immediately for all Emergencies! Do not wait for the Medical Contacts.

- 1. Medical Contacts:
 - a. 911
 - b. Event Trainers located at the Medical Tent
 - c. Event Manager via scorekeeper radio: David Raflo (952) 221-4477
 - d. Tournament Director via scorekeeper radio: Gabriel Knowles, Michelle Passi
- 2. Basic first aid is available at the Event Medical Tent
 - a. Scratches, abrasions, minor cuts
 - b. Sprains
- A Fire Station with Ambulance and EMT staff is located 6 miles from the Event Location.
 Response time is < 15 minutes. Ambulances can access the road immediately adjacent to the fields and drive onto the fields if necessary.
- 4. The nearest hospitals with Emergency Facilities are:
 - a. Georgetown Community Hospital (5 miles) 502-868-1100
 - i. Exit Kentucky Horse Park by turning right onto Ironworks Pike
 - ii. Continue 1.5 miles to the end of Ironworks Pike
 - iii. Turn Right onto Georgetown Road
 - iv. Continue 2.9 miles. Georgetown Road will change names to Lexington Road
 - v. Turn right into the Emergency Room at 1140 Lexington Road
 - b. University of Kentucky Hospital (10 miles) 859-323-5901
 - i. Exit Kentucky Horse Park by turning left onto Ironworks Pike
 - ii. Continue 1.7 miles to the Stop Sign
 - iii. Turn right onto Newtown Pike
 - iv. Continue 6.0 miles. Newtown Pike will change names to Oliver Lewis Way in downtown Lexington.
 - v. Turn left onto High Street
 - vi. Continue 0.6 miles to the stoplight at South Upper Street
 - vii. Turn Right onto South Upper Street
 - viii. Continue 1.3 miles to Hospital Drive

- ix. Turn left onto Hospital Drive and the University of Kentucky Hospital Emergency Room at 1000 South Limestone
- 5. Event Manager will make decisions prior to games or during games to stop play due to heat or weather. Follow on Twitter, https://twitter.com/USAUltimate and with #USAUD3CHAMPS
- 6. Communication will be through email and twitter prior to games. Communication at the fields will be through Public Announcement and through Scorekeepers via radio.





2017 USA Ultimate DIII Championships Weather Plan

Kentucky Horse Park, Lexington, KY May 20-21, 2017

All are expected to notify tournament staff if they see lightning or observe other dangerous weather.

- 1. Event Organizers may be reached at the headquarters tent or through any scorekeeper via radio:
 - a. Event Manager: David Raflo (952) 221-4477
 - b. Tournament Directors: Gabriel Knowles & Michelle Passi
- 2. Event Organizers will make decisions regarding weather and field conditions.
- 3. Communication will be through email and twitter prior to games. Communication at the fields will be through Public Announcement and through Scorekeepers via radio.
- 4. No back-up fields or make-up dates are planned for the 2017 DIII Championships. Event Organizers will make every effort to schedule make-up games. Changes to the schedule will be communicated through email by the Event Organizers.
- 5. If lightning is observed prior to games or during games, all players are expected to follow the Flash-to-Bang policy: Begin counting when a lightning flash is sighted. Stop counting when the associated thunder is heard. Divide the count by five to determine how far away the lightning is. 30 seconds equals about six miles. Lightning has been known to strike from as far away as 10 miles, even under clear skies. By the time the Flash-to-Bang count has reached 30 seconds, all individuals should return to their vehicles. At least 30 minutes after the last flash of lightning or sound of thunder the event manager and tournament directors will call for a brief captain's meeting to discuss the resumption of play. - 6. If the Heat Index reaches 100°F, play will be suspended
