IWSP Athletic Field Rules and Regulations for 2019

I just wanted to go over a few IWSP park rules for tournaments before this weekend's event.

- 1. Parking near the fields is **RESTRICTED TO 60 TOTAL CARS**. Park in the yellow highlighted area of the attached map ONLY. All cars parked beyond the gate must be removed 30 minutes after play has concluded.
- 2. The Community Center building will be closed, but can be opened for emergency weather situations, if necessary.
 - a. Portable restrooms are located next to the athletic fields.
- 3. Any "pop-up" tents need to be weighed down.
 - a. Just staking the tents into the premier fields will not be enough. The sand that is under the grass does not hold stakes as well as clay dirt would.
 - b. Tents cannot be staked into the premier fields if the stakes are longer than 6" due to the risk of hitting irrigation lines.
 - c. We lost several tents at events last year and it is usually a little windier here than everywhere else.
- 4. Please make sure to let teams know that all garbage needs to find a garbage bag, can or be packed out. *This includes organic materials such as banana peels, orange peels, and apple cores.*
 - a. Recycling containers will be located throughout the facility. Any recyclable material will be accepted as long as it is clean and empty of any food/liquids when being placed in recycling container.
- 5. Dogs are allowed at the park, but they must be leashed and you must pick up waste.
- 6. IWSP Staff will have a two-way radio to use for communication with your event.
