


Log into your account at <https://play.usultimate.org/members/login/>

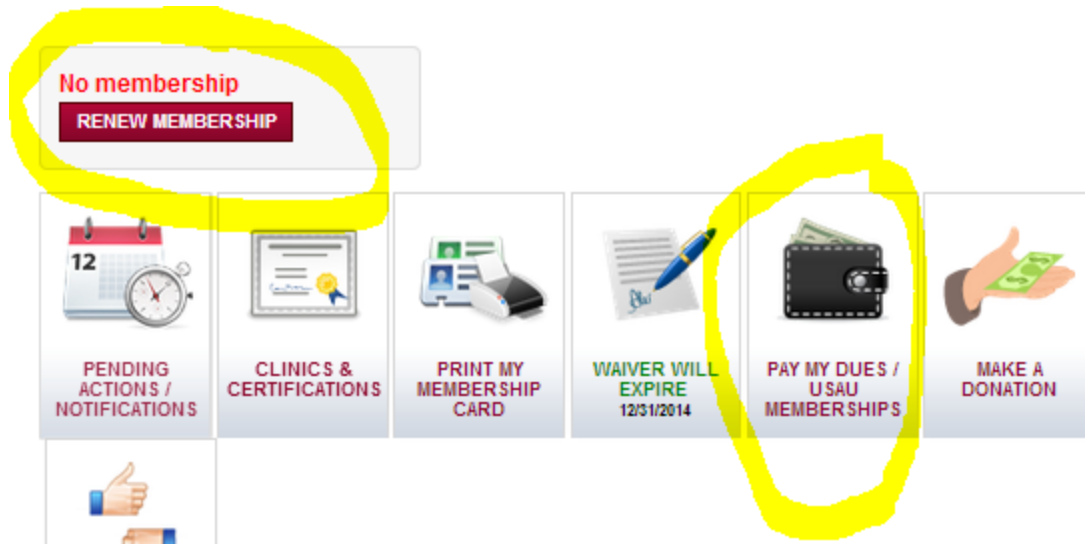

Once in your account & on your homepage, if you see “No membership” in red letters (below the “View/Edit Your Information” red button), then there are 2 places where you can purchase a calendar-year membership:

- 1) The “Renew Membership” red button directly underneath the “No membership”
- 2) The box/button with “Pay My Dues/USAU Memberships” in red letters



Select the membership that is most appropriate for your needs &/or demographic situation. There is a link to details on membership options above the list of options, as well as some notes on the newer & less obvious types of membership.

After you select the appropriate level, click the “Next” button through the various screens before you can check out with PayPal. Note that you do not need a PayPal account -- you can enter your debit or credit card details for one-time processing, without allowing PayPal to store, by clicking the “Pay with a credit or debit card” link directly below the login fields (be sure to uncheck the box that says “Save this information with a PayPal account” below the email address field):
